

Meetings

A copy of the minutes from the most recent Board meeting is attached. The next Board meeting will be on February 28th.

Congratulations and best wishes to Charlene Bray, who was elected to fill out the remainder of the open Board position. Charlene will assume responsibility as Treasurer, and Chris Scheiff will become Secretary.

As mentioned last month, the Board has authorized the creation of an ad-hoc committee to evaluate our revenue stream, and offer recommendations for closing the gap between our income and our expenses. Shirley Carlson will schedule the first meeting, at which time a chairperson will be selected, and committee membership will be finalized. Right now it is being called the "Revenue Stream Committee" because it will make recommendations for funding our Operating Account, our Reserve Account, and offer suggestions for a possible Special Assessment.

This was brought home to us when we learned that condos are now required to transfer 10% of their dues to fund reserves if buyers want to have FHA financing. While this is not yet the case for Planned Communities, our attorneys tell us, we should expect it in the near future.
