Projects Update

Roof Repairs – Repairs have been done to the roof on building 4 and the garage of 7. Bids for a new roof are being taken for building 4; water damage to both the exterior and the interior has been discovered.

Moss removal bids are being sought for roofs of several buildings

Tree Removal – Four trees that posed a danger to buildings 5 and 6 were removed, and the stumps ground down. The shavings will be removed by General Tree this week.

Rain Drains – Clogged drainpipes in front of buildings 13, 9, and 15 were scoped with a camera, and six were determined to be clogged by tree roots. Bids are being taken for replacement of the pipes that channel rainwater from gutters away from the buildings.

Sump Pumps - Units with Sump Pumps can soon expect a call from CMI to schedule an appointment to check the crawls spaces of their units.

Sidewalk pressure washing – A bid from Absolute Perfection Landscaping has been accepted, and work on locations that need it most, will begin as soon as the leaves are down. **Gutters and Downspouts** – Will also be cleared when the tree leaves are down.
